## DISCLAIMER

*I have attempted to transcribe exactly as recorded on the Census Return Forms, including any mistakes made by the Enumerator. There are several suspect entries which may be mistakes.*

1. Page 2 Jenkins Family – Son's name recorded as ALIOYNE which seems curious. Edgson Family – Wife's name recorded as CANNAH which may be a mistake for Hannah.
2. Page 3 Mold Family – Wife's name recorded as MIRRIA which may be a mistake for Maria. Trussler Family – Wife's place of Birth recorded as "Surrey, Hambotten" which must be
3. Page 5 Emma Farminer's place of Birth recorded as "Sussex, Ludgers Hall" which must be Ludgershall.
4. Page 8 Stevens Family – Servant Herbert Sparkes' place of Birth recorded as "Herts., Hatfield Dasit". There is Hatfield but no Dasit.
5. Page 10 Henry Mercer's place of Birth recorded as "Surrey, Lapcombe". There is no such place in Surrey.
6. Page 14 Ida Cooper's place of Birth recorded as "Hants., Whimpson". There is no such place in Hants., but could be Winchfield.
7. Page 18 "Henry Seury" is probably Henry Sewry.
8. Page 19 Hugh Hunt's place of Birth given as "Dorset, Stour". This is probably Stourpaine.
9. Page 23 Drudge Family. Aubrey is recorded as "Daughter".
10. Page 29 Stevens Family. Wife's place of Birth recorded as "Surrey, Alford". This must be
11. Page 30 Harrison Family. Son Henry's place of Birth recorded as "Surrey, West Green". There is no such place in Surrey but there is in Hampshire or it could be a mistake for
